In 1948, during and following the War for Independence, impressive numbers of Jews and some non-Jews went to help the fledgling country defend itself against an onslaught of Arab armies. Mickey Marcus, (Cast a Giant Shadow) is one name that comes to mind. Throughout its 71 years as the modern State of Israel there have been others who have stood up to defend this gem in the Middle East, in various capacities. This Shabbat offers a unique program designed to explore the recent phenomenon of the Lone Soldiers, young men and women who leave the comforts of their homes in their native countries to serve in the IDF for a specific period of their life. 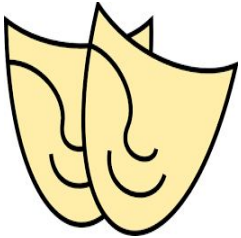

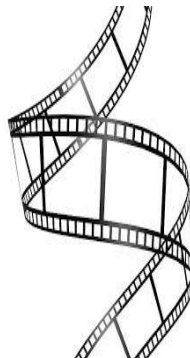
